About: The HSPT is a nationally-recognized private, high school entrance examination available to students as part of the private school application process. It is used to assist with admissions, scholarship selection, and curriculum placement. The HSPT is a comprehensive placement test for eighth graders for placement in the ninth grade.

Test Length: Approx. 3 hours (with breaks)

Test Dates & Locations: There is no national administration of the HSPT. Check with the school to which you are applying to find out when they will be administering the test.

Registration: Registration is handled by individual schools; check with the school to which you are applying to find out when you should register for the exam.

Test Fees: The cost of the test is included in the school's application fee. Check with the school to which you are applying to find out what the fee is.

Test Subjects & Format: The exam covers five subject areas: Verbal, Quantitative Skills, Reading Comprehension, Mathematics Skills, and Language.

Grading:

Raw Score:

For each question answered correctly, the student receives 1 point.

Scaled Score:

The raw score is then converted into a scaled score. Each section receives a scaled score between 200-800.

Combined Score:

To create a total combined score, the scaled scores for each section are averaged. The combined score will then also be a number between 200-800. A perfect score on the HSPT is an 800.

Percentile Rank & Grade Equivalent:

When the score is provided to the child and parents, the score report will indicate localized and national ranking. The performance level of each student will be shown as a grade equivalent.

FAQs

IS the HSPT standardized? Since the HSPT is used for admission by many Catholic schools, the test is offered in customized form to those schools desiring additional admission criteria, such as mechanical aptitudes, scientific knowledge, or religious knowledge. The conventional test is consistent with state-mandated testing in the areas of language skill, vocabulary, and reading. In the mathematics sections, the test content is also consistent with state requirements in arithmetic, basic geometry and algebra.

How many times can I take the HSPT? You may take the HSPT only once. According to the STS website, if you take the test more than once, your lower score will be used.

When should I start preparing for the HSPT? Each private school will accept applications at different times; check with the school to which you are applying to find out when applications begin. Plan to prepare for the HSPT a couple months in advance so that there is plenty of time to practice!

How much math do I need before I can start preparing for the HSPT? The math on the HSPT covers topics from arithmetic, elementary algebra, and very basic geometry.

FAQs CONTINUED

Is there a difference between the Verbal and Language sections? There is a difference between the Verbal Skills sections and the Language Skills. Verbal Skills is focused upon synonyms, antonyms, analogies and logic. Language Skills, the last section of the standard version of the HSPT, is devoted to those elements associated with writing: punctuation, capitalization, usage, and spelling.

How long does it take to get my scores back? Check with your school to find out when they will have scores available for your student.

What is a good score on the HSPT? A score above 600 will generally be somewhere "above average," which means above the 80th percentile. Each individual school defines what a desirable score is for each candidate, as some schools are more competitive than others.

What are the additional factors that play into K-12 Admissions: Grades, OLSAT scores, teacher recommendations, interviews and other factors play important roles in admissions, as well. The interview is more important than some students might think. Prepare by coming up with answers to common questions that may be asked; even if there is no wrong answer, responses that demonstrate maturity tend to be better.

HSPT vs. ISEE

Both the HSPT and the ISEE are nationally administered standardized tests that help private schools evaluate candidates. Below is a chart summarizing the differences:
